The Kalgoorlie-Boulder Chamber of Commerce & Industry Inc (KBCCI) was established in 1901 and incorporated in 1903.


KBCCI continues to pride itself on representing the business community with a strong and well-informed voice. We are a member-driven not for profit organisation.

Advocacy

KBCCI's primary mission is to engage with key stakeholders regularly on issues that are affecting the Goldfields region. Through representation on key stakeholder groups, KBCCI lobbies and advocates for our members and through collaboration, common goals are achieved. By consulting with our members on a regular basis and seeking input through surveys and personal consultation, we are able to represent the region on a number of matters with an informed voice.

In 2022, in response to the impact that the lack of land and housing in Kalgoorlie-Boulder is having on the region's ability to capitalise on current and future economic opportunities, we collaborated with local stakeholders and produced the Kalgoorlie-Boulder Land and Housing Position Paper. The two-part report contains the results collated from comprehensive research and offers actions and solutions to address the issues. Since its release in November 2022, the paper has been distributed to stakeholders as well as State and Federal Government and will continue to be a valuable tool for KBCCI in lobbying and advocacy.

Networking and Promotion

One of KBCCI's strengths is our extensive business network. Networking is the most powerful marketing tactic to accelerate, grow and sustain success for any individual and business. KBCCI has created exclusive events to highlight not only businesses, but the whole Goldfields Community. KBCCI creates opportunities for everyone to be involved in the region's development, by attending our Business After Hours, sub committee meetings, business luncheons or forums.

KBCCI's main resources are our communication channels. From social media reaching over 7,000 people weekly, our exclusive Goldfields-Esperance regional business directory and our weekly e-newsletters, we have developed strong communication tools to promote the business community. There are also a range of sponsorships packages available for all KBCCI events, enabling businesses to increase their brand visibility, public recognition and access to new business relationships.

Initiatives

KBCCI is proud to continually introduce new initiatives to support our members and the business community.

KBCCI launched the Residential Housing Showcase Project in November 2020, as a way for the KBCCI to showcase products and services of our members and local businesses through the construction of a four-bedroom, two-bathroom house. In July 2022, we were pleased to announce the completion of the project, a 99% KBCCI member-built home, in collaboration with over thirty local businesses.

In July 2022, KBCCI collaborated with the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder on the Pop Up - KB Collective, a pilot project aiming to create an engaging commercial space and shop-front opportunity for home-based local businesses, emerging enterprises and creatives. A number of local businesses were able to showcase their products and services at 226 Hannan Street during this six month initiative.

In partnership with our #shoplokalwa initiative, our KalDollar\$ Vouchers continue to go from strength to strength with over \$130,000 spent to date in over 70 local businesses. Keeping \$130,000 in the Goldfields!
