



Terms and Conditions for Raffle Draw

1. Eligibility

- 1.1. The raffle draw is open to individuals aged 18 years or older.
- 1.2. You cannot enter a receipt from a shop from place of your employment
- 1.3. Receipts must be from a retailer or trader that have shop frontages on Hannan Street between Wilson Street and Porter Street, and in Burt Street between Brookman Street and Hamilton Street.
- 1.4. KBCCI (Kalgoorlie-Boulder Chamber of Commerce and Industry) staff are not eligible to enter the raffle draw.

2. Entry Requirements

- 2.1. Participants can enter the raffle draw by submitting a receipt from a qualifying retailer or trader, or more than one receipt equalling to the total value as required by the specific event. For example, if the event is asking for a receipt value of \$50.00, you may have one \$40.00 receipt and two \$5.00 receipts.
- 2.2. There is no limit to the number of entries; participants can enter as many times as they like, provided each entry is accompanied by a separate qualifying receipt.
- 2.3. Each receipt submitted must have the participant's name and phone number clearly stated on the back.
- 2.4. If the event invitation specifies that receipts must be from the day of the event, only receipts dated on the specified day will be accepted.
- 2.5. Different events may request different values of receipts.

3. Participation in the Draw

- 3.1. Participants must be present at the draw to claim a prize. If a prize is not claimed within a reasonable time of the draw, then further draws will take place until the prize is claimed by a participant who is present.

4. General Terms

- 4.1. By entering the raffle, participants agree to abide by these terms and conditions.
- 4.2. The decision of the organisers are final and binding in all matters related to the raffle draw.
- 4.3. The organisers reserve the right to disqualify any entries that do not comply with these terms and conditions or are deemed to be fraudulent.
- 4.4. The organisers are not responsible for any loss or damage arising from or in connection with the raffle draw, including but not limited to entries that are lost, misdirected, or delayed.
- 4.5. Participants agree that personal data provided in connection with the raffle draw may be used for the purposes of administering the draw and contacting winners.
